Ray Theep, liaison from Ref's association, addressed jewelry issue. Ray read excerpts of the rule regarding jewelry which essentially bars jewelry from being worn unless it is either medical or religious in nature AND is not a danger to the player. Refs will comply with whatever our league policy is. A motion was made and seconded to change the policy regarding jewelry as follows: "Jewelry is not recommended. Flat or small jewelry that can be safely taped is acceptable."

Additionally there have been problems with ref's not starting games on time and cutting games short of the full time. Ray reminded all to use Blue Evaluation Forms to record problems. Carole will leave a stack of forms in the Robb field shed.

There was a reminder that March 25th is the deadline to add players for the winter season.

Sherry stated that the file box containing new player cards is in the PWSL shed. Unless otherwise notified, any new player cards can be picked up from the file box. Please do not leave registration forms there as these will NOT be picked up.

Carole mentioned that there will be a banner on the PWSL website that would inform teams/players of any rainouts. Teams playing at 9am will be called, but teams playing in subsequent games should check the website for possible rainouts.

Fields: Pt Loma will be narrower now because of Track equipment in the way on the sidelines. This is an ongoing issue during Spring track season.

City of San Diego rec councils are evaluating methods for leagues to provide proof of residency. PWSL received notification that KMRC wanted copies of players' utility bills. However, due to many objections, they are in the process of considering other options. This is coming about because of the budget crisis...as the fee for non-residency is twice that of residents.

Missed meeting fee is \$25.

Kanda will be working on the schedule this weekend. Carole asked how many teams are going to the Las Vegas tournament. We may want to canvass the team managers early next winter season to determine if the league should continue to avoid scheduling games during the two Las Vegas tournament weekends.
