

PWSL League Meeting Minutes April 2, 2007

Called to order 7:05 p.m.

It was reminded that board member positions were for two year terms and that nominations would be needed for the following positions at the May meeting. Brief descriptions for all board members were provided.

Registrar, Field Coordinator, VP/Equipment Manager, Statistician

Summer session will be June 11 – August 31. Fee will be announced soon and should be about the same as last year. \$200 deposits will be due May 7th – NO EXCEPTIONS. Scheduling requests must be to Scheduler (Michelle) by May 14. Depending on number of teams we will probably play Monday thru Thursday. There will probably be 2 divisions – one open and one aged again depending on the number of teams that register for the session. Teams can merge in the summer. Any registered player can play on any team. We will use Lindberg, Alcott, Kearny Mesa Rec. We are working on restroom facilities at Alcott.

Carole Hurst raised the possibility of having summer league be Co-ed. There were about 4 teams initially interested. Men who are registered on another league would not have to register with PWSL. Co-Ed will be worked on separately. Suggestions were raised of possibly playing 9v9. It was decided to leave it as it is as play would go on even if teams were short because they can share players.

Due to May 6th Field 9 unavailability, the Field 9 games have to be rescheduled to May 6th **3PM** on other Robb Fields. The 9am game (When's Lunch vs Shooters) will be played at 3pm on Field 1. The 11am game (Tiny's Comets vs FA United) will be played at 3pm on Field 3. The 1pm game (Stingers vs UCSD Tritons) will be played at 3pm on Field 8.

Carole reminded all O30 teams that they cannot borrow under 30 sister players even if they have U30 players that were grandfathered on the 30s team. A team manager request was made that aged teams please respect the fact that players choose to play on a team that fits their ability level and get discouraged when players are borrowed from higher division teams. The team manager also suspected abuse by borrowing more than the maximum of 3 players. Carole stated that as long as a player is 30 they may be playing on the 30A team either as a registered player or as a sister player. Teams are encouraged to inspect player cards if they think a team is using illegal players. The Board will be looking at final standings to determine if adjustments need to be made.

Clarification of the No Slide rule for O30's. It is defined as a move in which a field player leaves their feet. The current policy states that there is no sliding (rather than no slide tackling). Ray will pass this on to the Referee Association.

An issue was raised regarding the jewelry rule. The final decision rests with the Referee despite the fact that League Policy states that jewelry may be worn as long as it is safe. Referee Liaison Ray Theep commented

that it is very difficult to make a single rule that covers all situations. Every referee will be a little different and though he hopes most players would make good decisions but each ref will make what he/she considers to be the best decision for the situation.
