Rainouts – league decision was made early in the year to schedule regular games for the last 2 weeks of May rather than reserving weeks for rain make-ups. However there are fields available June 4 if any teams want to play that weekend to accommodate the third rainout this year. Teams have until Sunday April 10 to reply to pwslboard@pwsl.org if they DO want a make-up game scheduled on June 4. Only those teams who reply will be scheduled to play.

There were 2 significant injuries during April 19 games. If an injury occurs we must make sure the referee notes the injury on his game report although the referee should take responsibility to do so. It would be helpful for the team members to confirm that the referee makes the appropriate notes on the lineup card (especially if it's questionable whether or not there is a reportable injury. The league's insurance will not consider any claims unless the referee report is filed. If the team is not sure whether or not the report was filed – email the statistician (Jackie). Referee's association will solicit the report.

Webmaster has been working on the website to improve the site. Volunteers were solicited to review the proposed changes and provide ideas for improvement. Volunteers – Jamie Jones, Katie Michelmore, Brooks Holman. One of the aims is to have current game status available for rain outs. Another is to have bulletin board postings for new players (although not available yet), etc. There will also be a link for Tournament information.

Summer Soccer – deposits will be due at the May meeting (which is the last meeting of the year). If teams are short let Carole know and she will help hook up ½ teams. Summer league will start the first week of June, week nights Monday thru Thursday, beginning at 6:15. Will possibly consider different formats (7V7, Coed) for summer 2006. Fee should be about \$650 for returning teams.

Nominations for new board members will be taken at the May meeting. Positions are:

Field Coordinator – attend meetings for Councils that govern the fields. Approximately every 3 months make reservations for fields that are to be used the upcoming season.

Registrar – Cyclical duties involving getting registration packets organized – Fall registration took approximately 60 hours, Winter took about 25 hours. A lot of time is involved in follow up for missing information.

Other position descriptions will be made available by the next meeting. A new position of VP may be created to help facilitate the process of training a prospective President.
