League meetings are held monthly on the first Monday of the month except holidays in which case the meeting will be on the first Tuesday.

#### **FALL SESSION:**

Please send team rosters to Sherry Marti at Registrar @pwsl.org as soon as possible either by email or snail mail. Sherry's home address for mail is on the registration form. Deadline for all player registrations is August 22<sup>nd</sup> in order to play the first game Sunday Sept 9. Season ends Nov. 18. Returning players only need to file a new registration form. New players to the league must turn in a registration form, driver's license copy and digital photo.

**Registration fee** of \$825 for returning teams and \$925 for new teams. \$200 deposit due tonight and balance due at the September meeting.

The O35 division is now O36. Players must turn 36 within calendar 2007 to be eligible.

**Fall fields** available are Mira Mesa Rec, Westview upper and Lower, Alcott, Challenger and Lindberg. We are still pursuing the possibility of Lopez Ridge because it has restrooms. The final fields will be decided once the final team count is in. Special requests will be due by August 22 (byes, field preferences, etc) The schedule will be finished by August 28. All sister teams must declare themselves to the scheduler in order to make sure consideration of your sister team is made in the schedule.

**Interdivision play** – The scheduler will make every effort to schedule interdivision play between top teams of a lower division against lower teams of the higher division. If your teams does not want to play interdivision games you must notify the schedule.

**Sistering:** O30 can sister with O36. Play is determined by age only.

**Goal Transportation:** We need paid volunteers to help transport goals for the fall. The league will pay \$25 per location for either drop off or pick up. Marissa Sklehyan (858-336-5726) offered to have the goals stored at her condo in Mira Mesa. She lives close to Wagenheim. Please canvas your teams to see if anyone is able to help with goal transport.

Teams who finished in the top of bottom of their division can request to move up or down but will not be required to.

**Ray Theep** asked that we PLEASE make sure to have the refs fill out their names on the blue form before the game starts. This will enable the referees association to be able to evaluate the appropriate referees depending on the input turned in (positive and negative) on the blue cards. This is the only vehicle for evaluation for this league. Please use it. There are more officials being assigned to our league now than there were 5 years ago which the association will help with the
