Call to order: 7:05pm

Motion to approve minutes from February: Michelle Wegner, seconded by Dawn Lee

Ray Theep (referee liaison and President of the referee's association):

- Pt. Loma High has a pole vault pit placed on what was part of playing field, causing the field to be narrowed by about 15 yards. After some discussion, it was decided to continue playing on the field as is rather than try to reschedule games or find a new field at this point.
- Teams need to return the green referee evaluation cards to Jackie Armstrong to enable Ray to discipline those refs who are not on time, do not know/enforce league rules, etc. Carole mentioned that some refs sit and wait for the teams to take the field rather than be proactive about starting the game.
- Refs should return cards to manager/captain but team should be responsible for getting their cards back. The refs at this point of season should be checking players in via the cards.
- Refs should notify teams if halves are to be shortened.
- Red card reports should be received by PWSL by Wednesday following game

Equipment:

- Robb #1 is the only field to use the portable goals in the shed; Robb #8 and 9 are to use goals from the enclosure

We would appreciate as a courtesy if you would please return the goals/nets immediately after the game so they won't have to wait.

Schedule:

- There were several teams which voiced complaints with the new schedule, i.e. one "A" team plays another three times and then doesn't play another in their division at all. Other issues concerned playing teams in their division only once. The schedule will be reviewed and a revised schedule may be issued.
